No. 1. August 16th 1834

The Committee Chosen by the Church of Christ in Phillips and the Committee chosen by the Church in No. 1. Met at Brother Hanson Cooks to attend to difficulties existing between our Brethren John M. Kinne and Hosea Dunham

Opened the Meeting by prayer to God

- 1 Chose Brother Joel Whitney Moderator
- 2 Chose Brother John Sargent Clerk

After conversing together ~~together~~ relative to the difficulties before us the two aggrieved Brethren agree to relate their dealings together from whence the difficulty arose and submit to the decision of the two Committees

After relating their dealings together in temporal matters it was thought best for all to pray together and the Power of God was present the two Brethren took each other by the hand confessed their wrongs and agree to drop all their difficulties and hard thoughts brews and strive to live together in love and in the service of God
