6th Agreed to adjourn the meeting four weeks to

- Heard the report of Bro. Henry Wilbur as committed to visit Sister Mary Bredy
- 2 Voted to accept the report which is favourable
- 3 Chose Bro. John Sargent Jr. to visit Brother Isaac Thomas
- 4 Chose Bro. Henry Wilbur to visit Bro. Stowers and his family
- 5 Chose Bro. Hanson Cook to visit Bro. S. King
- 6 Chose Bro. Hanson Cook Messenger to next 2. M.
- 7 Chose Dea. John Smith Substitute
- 8 Voted that this Meeting be dissolved

- 4 Chose Elder Dyer, Elder Scales and Bro. Samuel Stowers Committee for that purpose
- 5 Voted that this Meeting be adjourned to Saturday next at 9 o'clock at this place

Met for Church Meeting according to Adjournment
Opened the Meeting by prayer

- Elder Scales and Elder Dyer report an agreeable visit with Bro. John Sargent and a prospect of his returning to the Lord
- 1 Voted to accept the report
- Brother Stowers reports a short interview with Bro. Sargent and that he knows of nothing grievous

- 2 Voted to accept the Report
 Brother Hanson Cook reports that he has visited
 Bro. John Sargent and found some things that
 were disagreeable but were measurably removed
- 3 Report accepted
- 4 Voted that our Brethren Ebenezer Whitney and
 Samuel Farnice take an active part with us.
- 5 Dea. Cook and Dea. Smith report that they
 have not visited Bro. Sargent and were excused
 Heard the Report of the Committee chosen
 to visit Bro. Henry Wilbur and wife which
 was unfavourable
- 6 Accepted the Report
 Brother Wilbur states that he has been in
 a backslidden state for a long time and
 magnified difficulties but is now determined
 to lay aside things against the Brethren and
 serve God and asked their forgiveness
- 7 Adjourn to Bro. Hanson Cook at 5 o'clock
 Met according to adjournment
- 8 Agree that the difficulty ^{between} Bro. Henry Wilbur and
 Bro. Hanson Cook be postponed to next Ch. Meeting
 Chose Dea. J. Smith to visit Bro. John M. Kinnear
- 10 Adjourn to 3^d Sat. in July. John Sargent Clerk

Saturday July 15th 1837

- Met for Church Meeting and Opened by Prayer
- 1 Took up the difficulty between Bro. Hanson Cook
 and Bro. Henry Wilbur and adjourned till after
 Meeting of Worship tomorrow
 Sunday 16th Met according to adjournment
 and the two Brethren settled their difficulty
 to the satisfaction of the Brethren
 - 2 Heard the Report of Dea. Smith on visiting
 Sister Martha Whitney which was favourable
 the report accepted
 - 3 Adjourn to 3^d Saturday next month 10 o'clock
 Closed by giving thanks
 After some conversation chose Elder Dyer
 to visit sisters Mary Rollins and Sarah Stevens
 though not members of this Church

- At the August Church Meeting Dea. Smith
 was chosen Messenger to D. Mt. and voted to comply
 with the request of the D. Meeting and Adjourn to
 3^d Saturday in next month
- The September Church Meeting was Opened
 and adjourned to 2^d Saturday in October 10 o'clock

3 Chose Brethren Henry Wilbur and Hanson Cook Messengers to next 2^d Meeting

4 Voted Bro. Henry Wilbur enquire into the state of the fund of this Church and report

5 Voted this Meeting be adjourned five weeks 10 o'clock
Closed by prayer and giving thanks
