to preach with us one fourth of the Sabbaths for the ensuing & continue to exercise the pastoral care of the Church - On the morrow Eld. M. closes the seventh year of his ministry with this Ch. one fourth of the time annually.

- 4 Voted. That Dea Samuel Stowers be a committee to solicit subscriptions for the support of preaching one fourth of the time the coming year & that his efforts be restricted to Madrid, as another paper will be circulated in the upper part of Phillips.
- Adj. to meet in four weeks from this P.M. at close of conference at the Prescott School House.

Ch. met in conference at the Prescott School House, April 10<sup>th</sup> 58 - Sad. going, & yet a goodly number were present. Excellent spirit prevailed. At the close of the conference, met in Ch. meeting.

1. Voted - That action of the brethren who met in Ch. meeting four weeks ago at Wed. morning Eld. A. B. Merrill, to continue his services as the pastor of the Ch. another year, be reaffirmed by this meeting. Whereupon Eld. M. accepted the invitation & entered upon the eighth year of his connection with the Ch. as their minister 4<sup>th</sup> of the Sabbath.
2. Voted that brethren Jeremiah Beedy & Daniel Field, be added to the committee to solicit subscriptions in support of A. B. Merrill, the ensuing year.
3. By common consent it was agreed,

1858 that the ordinance of baptism  
be administered in four weeks  
from to-morrow.

1858 Records of Madrid Church

Madrid Church met in conference at brackets corner, Saturday July 31, 1858, Twenty five present, very good meeting, at the close of conference the meeting was called to order for business, by A. W. Morell,

- 1. Voted, that a committee of three be appointed to investigate the case of Bro. Small who offered himself to the ch. four weeks since,
- 2. Voted. That Daniel Field, Dea. John Smith & Cyrus Stowers be the committee of investi- gation,
- 3. Bro D Field not having visited Bro G. C. Beckett by common consent A. W. Morell was author- ized to see Bro G. & say to him that he has not been excluded from the ch. & that the confessions he has made of his backslidings, are satisfactory to his brethren & further that they would hold him in love & fellowship, as a member in good standing.

1 Voted, that Dea Sam<sup>l</sup> Stowers & So<sup>r</sup> Wm. Cook be the delegates to the next Gen<sup>l</sup> holden at Chesterville, on the 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> of Sept next, with power of substitution,

On Sabbath Aug 27<sup>th</sup> brethren Benj. Whittemore & James Lay, Roy Kimiston, were baptized by W. A. H. Maxwell in the stream south of Mr Israel Mc. Kennies, & united with the Ch<sup>h</sup> the right hand of fellowship being given on the shore by the administrators of the baptism, also, Sarah Jane Richardson,

Oct 27 Wed. P.M. Baptized bro Lewis Prescott & Sisters Mrs Mary A. Wing & Miss May E. Frothingham & gave them the right hand of fellowship in behalf of the Ch.

Nov 20 Met after conference at Stowers School House.

1 Appointed Dea J. Smith & Wm. Cook delegates to next Q.M. with power of substitution.

2 The committee appointed to investigate the case of bro Small who offered himself to the Ch. not having attended to that duty. Voted, that they be holded to attend to the same & report if consistent at the next conference.

Feb 12 Met after conference at the Dunkern School  
house Saturday P.M.

After remarks from Eld A.W. Morrell upon the  
subject of his duty to close his labours with the  
Church, for the present, on the morrow it  
being the end of the eighth year of his service  
as pastor of the Ch. preaching 4/4 of the time it  
was voted that the Ch. extend an invitation  
to Bro Sylvester P Jones of East Ware, Licentiate of  
the S.M. to preach with them 4/4 of the time  
the ensuing year

2 Voted that Daniel Field & Joshua Brackett  
be the committee to supply the desk the com-  
ing year & that <sup>they</sup> be instructed to invite Bro  
S.P Jones to preach with the Ch. 4/4 of the time

3 Voted that the above committee also solicit  
subscriptions for Bro Jones & attend to  
the collection of them in due time,
